Any student enrolled in a post-secondary educational institution in the greater Pittsburgh area is eligible to apply.

This award supports students working on a project of their choosing and on a small project to support 350Pittsburgh. Where possible, we will try to connect students with professionals or mentors in their project areas. A wide range of student projects are eligible: host an event or workshop, invite a speaker or show a movie, attend a workshop, develop a small research project or report, engage in community outreach.... The 350Pittsburgh project is also flexible, the student could table or take pictures at an event, draft a webpage, work on social media outreach, attend a lobbying event,

- An award of up to \$500 is granted over a 12 week semester
- Student project can be an individual or a group/club project.
- One application per student, please.
- All projects must be 501(c)3 (non-profit, non-political) compliant.
- Expected commitment of around 30 hours on the student project.
- Expected commitment of 6-8 hours on the 350Pittsburgh project.
